

VOTER REGISTRATION AND ABSENTEE INFORMATION

Websites, such as TurboVote, claim to be able to register you to vote and to send you an absentee ballot. Here is some clarifying information on voter registration and absentee voting in Wyoming.

You must register with the County Clerk or a registry agent (Town of Upton Clerk). Per W.S. 22-3-103, the following are required:

- full legal name
- current residence address
- postal address
- date of birth
- acceptable identification (W.S. 22-1-102(a)(xxxix))
- political party affiliation

To request an absentee ballot, per 22-9-104, you must contact the County Clerk in person, in writing, or by telephone, and provide the following:

- name in full, social security number (optional), date of birth, and current Wyoming residence address
- election for which the absentee ballot is requested
- political party (primary only)

A few more notes:

- You may request an absentee ballot for yourself and anyone else, but all of the above information must be provided.
- An absentee ballot can only be handed out to that registered voter, unless you provide a signed request from them; otherwise, it will be mailed to them.
- Absentee ballots must be returned to the County Clerk, either in person or by mail; they cannot be returned to a polling place.
- You may absentee vote now through Monday, August 20th.
- Primary Election Day is Tuesday, August 21st.
- The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. through 7:00 p.m.
- Polling places are Upton Community Center, Osage Fire Hall, and Newcastle State Forestry Building.
