WESTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OFFICIAL MINUTES May 7, 2024

The regular meeting of the Weston County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Don Taylor at 9:00 a.m. at the Weston County Courthouse. Commissioners Ed Wagoner, Nathan Todd, Garrett Borton and Vera Huber, Attorney Michael Stulken and Clerk Becky Hadlock were present. Mick Bohn opened the meeting with prayer, and Vice-Chairman Borton led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Clerk Hadlock asked to remove the Rare Earth Update and the Reporting on ARPA funds from the Agenda. Chairman Taylor asked to move the Public Comment and Commissioner Comment after New Business. Vice-Chairman Borton moved to approve the agenda as amended; seconded by Commissioner Huber. Carried.

FAIRGROUNDS

Fair Board member Francie Hamilton came before the Board to discuss an outstanding bill from the IRS. Commissioner Todd moved to pay \$8,108.33 out of the ARPA account 150.32.0029000.1226; seconded by Commissioner Wagoner. Discussion ensued. Carried. Ms. Hamilton discussed with the Board setting up an endowment fund for the Fairgrounds. This will be added to the agenda for the next meeting.

VACANCY LETTER

William Curley and Patricia Baumann came before the Board requesting for a letter from the Commissioners to the Wyoming Republican Party declaring the vacancies of Resolution 2024-10. Discussion ensued.

EMS DISTRICT

City Council member Ty Owens came before the Board asking to have the formation of an EMS District added to the ballot in the next election. Mayor Pam Gualtieri asked to have the County pay 1/2 of the City's current portion of the EMS charges. Commissioner Wagoner explained that the County could pass a resolution to form an EMS District, after this process what would be placed on the ballot would the passing of a MIL for the District.
