CONCERNING SPECIAL APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY ATTORNEY

WHEREAS the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney has agreed with the Goshen County Attorney's Office to investigate, and otherwise proceed to make, in their sole discretion, a proper disposition of all potential matters in which the Weston County Attorney's Office has declared a conflict of interest; and

WHEREAS the Goshen County Attorney's Office will, at their sole discretion, provide their services free of charge to Weston County in exchange for Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney's Office acting in their county free of charge when conflicts of interest arise in their respective County, however, the Weston County Attorney's Office shall reimburse them for all travel costs and expenses; and

WHEREAS Wyoming Statute 18-3-302(c) authorizes said action and it benefits Weston County; and

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners in and for Weston County, Wyoming that the Goshen County and Prosecuting Attorney and their respective deputies be and the same are hereby authorized to act as special deputy attorneys in Weston County, Wyoming when appointed by the Weston County and Prosecuting Attorney to act as such in any particular case or matters.

Motion made seconded and carried by the Board in an open meeting on the undersigned date.




